From this information we will complete a tenancy which will be sent to you by email.

Please ensure you send us the correct email address for ALL students and GUARAN-TOR. **

Please remember this tenancy is a legally binding agreement between you and the land-lord. This will be emailed out – it's like a chain. Once one student signs it goes to the next and so on. Once all students have signed it is automatically be sent to each guarantor in a chain also. We ask that agreements are read and signed when received. This is why is it so important that EMAIL addresses are sent correctly!

We require £300 deposit per student – to be sent ASAP.

FAQs

Utilities are not included.....

Oil – You will be notified of the level of oil in the tank at the beginning of your tenancy.

This must be left at this level when you vacate at the end of your tenancy.

Rentals that are priced weekly.....

There are 39 weeks in the academic year between 1st September – 31st May.

Weekly rent X 39 (weeks) / 9 months = 9 monthly equally payments.

Rent payments will be due September, October (4-month bulk instalment) and February (4-month bulk instalment) coinciding with student loan payments.
